BYLAW RESPECTING DEPOSIT BY CANDIDATES AT MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Bylaw # 2000-06

1. This Bylaw shall be known as the Election Deposit Bylaw. in accordance with the Municipal Elections Act, (Ss44,51):
2. A deposit in the amount of \$100.00 must accompany each Nomination Paper submitted for a general, or special municipal election.
3. The full deposit in the amount of \$100.00 is refundable, provided that:
 - 1)The candidate has been elected by vote, elected by acclamation, or is deceased prior to the election, and
 - 2)The candidate or agent has, within seven days following the election, filed an affidavit with the Clerk, indicating that he or she has removed all election advertising.
4. The candidate will forfeit the entire deposit if he or she fails to file the required affidavit within seven days following the election.
5. The previous Bylaw Respecting Deposits by Candidates at an Election, dated July 9, 1979, is hereby repealed.
